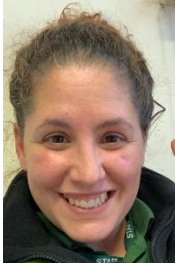

I am based in UK, currently with over 50 tanks (between 60 to 120 litres) designed for goodeids and pupfish. All currently with live plants, mix of riversand and gravel to mimic their natural habitats. LSS consist of sump with biomedica, UV, chiller, heaters and sponge filters. We can offer a wide variety of food like worms, live daphnia, mosquito larvae, vegs, flakes and pellets.

breeding success

I have been breeding over the past 3 years *Zoogoneticus tequila*, *Characodon lateralis*, *Ameca splendens*, *Ataeniobius toweri* and *Ilyodon furcoidens*. We recently introduced *Allotoca zacapuensis* in our collection (January 2022) and since then we had 20 fry, all growing well.

Motive force

We are designing few fish facilities to keep the most endangered species for insurance and research purposes, but currently we have the facilities, space and resources to be part of breeding programs. We have some space outdoors with few tanks (over 200 litres) where we can move animals out during summer period. We can offer our facilities for research and breeding to help endangered species like goodeids to bring them back!
